



With its signature island green twelfth hole, The Crossings Golf Club is perhaps the most unique layout in the Triangle area. The Front Nine features rolling terrain and panoramic vistas. The Back Nine meanders through acres of wetlands with water on seven of the nine holes. Designed by noted architect Ron Garl, The Crossings opened in November of 1997 and was ranked by North Carolina Magazine as one of the best new public courses in the state. The course may be played from four sets of tees measuring from 5,000 yards to 6,600 yards with a par of 71, offering a challenge to player of all abilities. The excellent condition of the Bermuda fairways and Bent grass greens make The Crossings one of the most enjoyable courses in the area.

The Crossings Golf Club is semi-private and offers several different membership structures. Please refer to Membership Fees for applicable initiation fees and monthly dues. The available membership categories are described as follows:

Member benefits:

- No green fee payment required
 - Reduced cart fee
- Advance preferred starting times
- Member only golf tournaments
- Reduced prices on equipment and apparel
- Special reduced rates for Guests playing with Member
 - Optional use of USGA Handicap Service

Regular Membership

The Regular Membership offers all of the amenities of the Club in the following subcategories: 1) *Individual* or 2) *Family* (two or more). The Family Membership includes immediate family consisting of the Member's Spouse and their unmarried children age 21 and under living at home or attending school on a full time basis.

Corporate Membership

The Corporate Membership is owned by the corporation and is subject to payment of membership dues and compliance with rules and regulations. Participants must be employees of the corporation holding the membership. Participants within the corporate structure are granted all of the privileges of the *Individual Regular* Membership.

Weekday Membership

The Weekday Membership offers all of the amenities of the Club Monday through Friday, excluding Holidays in the following categories: 1) *Individual* or 2) *Husband and Wife*.



General Membership Information

Regular and Weekday Memberships are owned by the individual and are non-transferable. Corporate Memberships are owned by the corporation and may be transferred within the corporation with the appropriate transfer fee.

Memberships are not assessable

Initiation Fee Payment Options

Regular and Corporate Initiation Fees may be financed interest free for 12 months with a down payment of fifty (50) percent.

Payment of dues may be made either annually or monthly by credit card draft on the first day of each month.

The Crossings Golf Club is a semi-private golf facility. We offer memberships as well as public play for a daily fee. By allowing daily fee play we are able to provide member services and continue to keep membership fees very affordable.



General Rules and Regulations

1. It is the intent of The Crossings Golf Club to limit rules and regulations to the minimum required for the mutual enjoyment of the club by all of its members and guests. The obligation of enforcing these rules and regulations is placed in the hands of management and the right to alter rules and regulations as deemed necessary is reserved as such.
2. Members and Guests must follow and adhere to all rules and regulations as set forth by The Crossings Golf Club. Any rules violations subject the membership to revocation.
3. The hours of operation shall be established considering the season of year.
4. Members may obtain starting times 14 days in advance. Guests may obtain starting times 7 days in advance. Management reserves the right to make alternative considerations for tournaments, special events and out-of-town guests.
5. Each member as a condition of membership and each guest as a condition of invitation to the Club facilities assume sole responsibility for his or her property.
6. Golf Cart requirements will be established on a seasonal basis. Golf Cart rules will be established on a day to day basis. Golf Carts must stay on cart paths around all tees and greens. All cart directional signs and roped areas must be observed.
7. No more than four players may play as a group unless specific authorization has been granted from the Pro Shop Staff.
8. No more than two golf carts per foursome and one golf cart per twosome allowed. Only two people may ride in any golf cart.
9. Each player must have a set of clubs.
10. All play shall begin from the first tee unless specific permission is granted from the Pro Shop Staff. All play shall begin in the order received from the Pro Shop Staff. The Pro Shop Staff has the authority to schedule starting times as circumstances may require.
11. Faster players must be allowed through if there is a clear hole open ahead of your group.
12. Ball marks must be repaired on the greens, divots must be filled with sand and bunkers must be raked.
13. Proper attire is required at all times. No T-shirts, cut-off jeans, swimsuits or tank tops are permitted. Men must wear sleeved shirts at all times. Soft or alternative spikes must be used. Steel spikes are not allowed.
14. It is the player's responsibility to be informed of and knowledgeable of the rules and regulations of the Club.



Membership Policies

1. Initiation Fee. Monthly or annual dues.

- Initiation Fee. A person desiring to become a Member of The Crossings Golf Club shall pay an Initiation Fee in an amount determined by the Club Owner, applicable to the category of Membership. The Initiation Fee is not refundable.
- Monthly/Annual Dues. Payment of the Initiation Fee alone does not entitle the Member to the use of the Club facilities. The Member must pay applicable dues as established by the Club Owner, either annually or monthly. In addition, the Club Owner may, in its sole discretion, establish guest charges, late fees and other fees and charges.

2. Regular Membership

- Individual. The Membership is issued in the name of one person and that person only is entitled to Member benefits.
- Family. The Membership is issued in the name of one person. That person and their immediate family shall be entitled to Member benefits. Immediate family includes the spouse of the Member and unmarried dependent children under the age of 21, living at home and attending school on a full time basis. A list of immediate family shall be kept in the Member's file at all times.

3. Weekday Membership

- Individual. The Membership is issued in the name of one person and that person only is entitled to Member benefits, Monday through Friday, excluding Holidays.
- Husband and Wife. The membership is issued in the name of one person and that person and spouse are entitled to Member benefits, Monday through Friday, excluding Holidays.

4. Corporate Membership

- A Corporate Membership shall be issued in the name of a corporation, partnership, Limited Liability Company or other legal entity. A minimum of four people required to be eligible for Corporate Membership. Each person assigned as Corporate Members will be entitled to the same Member benefits of the Regular Individual Membership. The corporate entity shall be subject to payment of Initiation Fees and Dues of all assigned members.

*All privileges of Membership are subject to the requirements and obligations set forth in **The Crossings Golf Club Rules and Policies**. All Memberships constitute revocable license to use the Club facilities in accordance with the category of Membership selected.*



Membership Policies, continued

5. Guest Privileges. Members are entitled to have guests accompanied by the Member or their immediate family use the facility upon payment of applicable fees and charges.
6. Transferability. Memberships are not transferable. A Member may not pledge, grant a security interest in, or otherwise use a membership as collateral for a loan or any other obligation.
7. Resignation. A Member may resign from Membership by giving 60 days written notice to the Club, whereupon the Membership shall terminate once all outstanding dues and charges are paid in full.
8. Suspension or Termination for Cause. Any Member may be suspended or terminated from Membership for non-payment of dues, fees or other charges, for violation of Club Rules or Policies or for other cause as determined by the Club Owner.
9. Modification of Membership Plan and Club Rules and Policies. The Club Owner reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to waive or modify the terms of this Membership Plan and Club Rules and Policies. Without limiting the foregoing, The Club Owner shall have the right to modify playing privileges, establish different categories of Membership and establish and/or modify the Rules and Policies governing access, sign-up privileges, starting times and other matters with respect to the Club facilities.
10. Summary. Membership in The Crossings Golf Club constitutes a revocable license to use the Club facilities, but does not give to the Member a vested or prescriptive right or easement to use the Club facilities. Membership in the Club is not an investment in the Club and does not provide equity or ownership interest in the Club or Club facilities. All Membership privileges and benefits are subject to the Membership Plan and The Crossings Golf Club Rules and Policies, which may be modified from time to time or terminated by the Club Owner at its sole discretion.
