GOLF TOURNAMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Deposits and Payments

A ten percent (10%) deposit of the entire tournament price will be required to reserve your tournament date (minimum deposit of \$200.00). The deposit is non-refundable unless either the Golf Course Superintendent or the General Manager deems the course unplayable on the day of the event. The balance of payment will be due **PRIOR** to the beginning of play on the day of the tournament. An approved credit card, corporate check or cash may be used for both deposit and payment.

Guarantee:

The guaranteed number of players must be confirmed seven (7) days in advance of the tournament date with a player roster and team assignment if applicable. The *TOURNAMENT COORDINATOR* will be responsible for providing The Crossings Golf Club with the above mentioned roster.

Cancellations:

The Crossings Golf Club shall reserve the right to cancel any tournament or modify the tournament logistics (i.e., starting time, starting method, starting hole, etc.) if the guaranteed number of players falls below seventy-five percent (75%) of the original number of players stated above. Although every effort will be made to maintain the original details of the tournament, changes may be necessary to fill unused golf course space. The *TOURNAMENT COORDINATOR* shall have the right to cancel the tournament up to thirty (30) days prior to the tournament date and receive a full refund of the deposit. Cancellations less than thirty (30) days prior to the tournament date will result in forfeiture of the entire deposit.

Inclement Weather:

In the event of inclement weather, the tournament will be played as long as the Golf Course Superintendent and/or The General Manager deem the course playable. If the course is deemed unplayable and is closed prior to the beginning of play, The Crossings Golf Club will make every effort to secure an alternate date for the tournament. If that should prove unfeasible, the tournament shall be given a full refund of the deposit.

Other terms and conditions:

Should the number of players exceed the number of players guaranteed, every effort will be made to adjust the tournament to accommodate those players.

In accordance with North Carolina Law, the entire golf course is a licensed premise. It is unlawful to bring alcohol onto the golf course property. All food and beverage must be purchased from The Crossings Golf Club unless prior arrangements are made with **The Crossings Golf Club**

Golf Carts are for players only. Carts are not available for spectators, tournament personnel, photographers or for transportation of beverages.

Tournament participants must adhere to the Rules and Policies of The Crossings Golf Club. The tournament organization or the Tournament Coordinator shall assume full responsibility for any and all damages done to the golf course, golf carts, golf course equipment or any other infractions of the rules. The Tournament Coordinator will be provided a copy of the Tournament Rules and Policies to be distributed to the participants.

GOLF TOURNAMENT FEE SCHEDULE

Starting Times

Shotgun Start

Monday – Thursday.....	72 players or \$2160.00 minimum
Friday.....	80 players or \$2800.00 minimum
Weekends*.....	92 players or \$4140.00 minimum

Players in addition to minimum requirements will be charged Basic Tournament Fees.

Tournaments utilizing a single Shotgun Start are limited to 124 players

*Weekend Shotgun Start Tournaments require an 8:00 AM starting time

Weekend afternoon Tournaments may start from the first and tenth tees

Consecutive Times from First and Tenth Tees*

Monday – Thursday.....	52 player minimum
Friday.....	60 player minimum
Weekends.....	60 player minimum

*First starting time will depend on Morning or Afternoon request

Tournaments not meeting minimum requirements will start consecutively from the First Tee.

General Rules

Members and Guests of The Crossings Golf Club must conduct themselves at all times while on the property in a manner consistent with the traditions of the game of golf.

1. It is the intent of The Crossings Golf Club to limit rules and regulations to the minimum required for the mutual enjoyment of the Club by all of its Members and Guests. The obligation of enforcing these rules and regulations is placed in the hands of management and the right to alter rules and regulations as deemed necessary is reserved as such.
2. Each member as a condition of membership and each guest as a condition of invitation to the Club facilities assume sole responsibility for his or her property.
3. Proper attire is required at all times. No T-shirts, cut-off jeans, swimsuits or tank tops are permitted. Men must wear sleeved shirts at all times. Soft or alternative spikes must be used. Steel spikes are not allowed.
4. All play must begin from the first tee unless specific permission is granted from the Pro Shop Staff. All play shall be in the order received from the Pro Shop Staff. The Pro Shop Staff has the authority to schedule starting times as circumstances may require.
5. No more than four players may play as a group unless specific authorization has been requested and granted from the Pro Shop Staff. Each player must have a set of clubs and bag.
6. Golf Cart requirements will be established on a seasonal basis. Golf Cart rules will be established on a day to day basis. Golf carts must stay on cart paths around all tees and all greens. All Golf Cart directional signs must be observed and obeyed. No more than two Golf Carts will be allowed for a foursome or threesome and one Golf Cart will be allowed for a twosome. Reckless driving of Golf Carts will not be condoned.
7. Ball marks must be repaired on greens, divots must be filled with sand and bunkers must be raked.
8. Damage to the golf course, golf carts or property of The Crossings Golf Club will result in immediate expulsion from the premises. Tournament Chairman will be held responsible for any and all damages.
